Critical Areas are for full-time staff as defined as a: secondary (or elementary specialist) math, science, English, social studies; and Sp. Ed, LOTE, ESL/Bilingual Coord, Counselor, Nurse, Librarian and Tech Director. Teachers with a master's degree receive an additional stipend. Secondary "content" teachers receive an additional stipend in addition to schedule "C." See 2017-2018 Stipend Schedule for additional benefits. All full-time staff will receive a \$100/year longevity benefit based on years of continuous employment in Sabinal ISD with a maximum benefit of \$1000.
